“Peter Disowns Jesus”

Luke 22:31-34, 54-62

March 6-7, 2010

“Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift you as wheat.” [v. 31]

“I have prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers.” [v. 32]

SERMON NOTES

“But he [Peter] replied, ‘Lord, I am ready to go with you to prison and to death.’” [v. 33]

“Jesus answered, ‘I tell you Peter, before the rooster crows today, you will deny three times that you know me.’” [v. 34]

SERMON NOTES

“Then seizing him [Jesus], they led him away and took him to the house of the high priest. Peter followed at a distance.” [v. 54]

“Just as he was speaking, the rooster crowed. The Lord turned and looked straight at Peter. Then Peter remembered the word the Lord had spoken to him; ‘Before the rooster crows today, you will disown me three times.’ And he went outside and wept bitterly.” [Vv. 60-62]
